Mold Is Everywhere!

Mold can grow on nearly any surface. There are molds that grow on wood, paper, carpet, cement, cinder block, and more. You may see mold on the grout in your bathroom, the side of your home, and in the crawlspace. In some cases you may smell mold; but many times you may not see OR smell the mold!

There are a growing number of journals, articles, and studies linking mold with serious health issues such as: Asthma, Fibromyalgia, Cancer, Cardiac/Pulmonary issues, and more. Symptoms may begin as flu-like; respiratory infections, headaches, rashes, aches, and poor sleep patterns. The higher the mold counts, and the longer the exposure lasts, the more serious the health issues can become.

The Mayo Clinic reported: “Researchers have found that chronic sinusitis, a condition that affects about 37 million people in the United States, is apparently caused by an immune response to fungus (mold).”

The EPA states: “All molds have the potential to cause health effects. Molds can produce allergens that can trigger allergic reactions or even asthma attacks in people allergic to mold.”

Most people are sick for quite some time before they test for mold; and

very few medical practitioners have experience with mold related health issues. Antibiotics and over the counter products are used widely to treat mold’s sinus and flu-like symptoms, but they are not effective because they target bacteria – not fungi! You may have a temporary lessening of symptoms, but these products do not treat the inflammation mold causes. Many patients are made to feel like hypochondriacs when these treatments don’t work for them.

So what can we do?

First, find out what types and levels of mold you have in your home. Get a test kit and send it to an independent lab for results.

Next, it’s critical to find out why, what and where the mold came from. If you treat your home and do not fix the cause, the mold will return in full force.
